#### Issue of Shares to CEO

Kresta Holdings Limited (ASX:KRS) announces that it has issued 3,000,000 ordinary fully paid shares to Mr Giuliano (Jules) Di Bartolomeo under the Company's Long Term Incentive Scheme which was approved by shareholders at the 2011 Annual General Meeting.

The shares were issues at 14.9 cents each, reflecting the volume weighted average market price of the shares for the 5 days prior to the offer of the shares being made to Mr Di Bartolomeo.

Under the terms of the Company's long Term Share Incentive Scheme, the Company has lent Mr Di Bartolomeo \$447,000, on a non-recourse basis.

The shares will be held in voluntary escrow with 1,500,000 shares being released in 20<sup>th</sup> August 2014 and the remaining 1,500,000 shares being released on the 20<sup>th</sup> August 2015.
